An update on FAFSA delays and the impact on fall admissions was delivered by campus enrollment management leaders: Kimberly DeRego, UNH vice provost for enrollment management; Joanne Landers, PSU vice president for enrollment management and communications; and MB Lufkin, KSC vice president of enrollment and student engagement. The delay, subsequent condensed admissions time frame, and federal changes to the financial need and family contribution formula all contribute to uncertainty in assessing fall enrollment and potential summer melt. Trustee Thronton announced a FAFSA completion outreach initiative to be conducted throughout the summer by Granite Edvance to encourage application for fall. Discussion touched on the enrollment constraints of the traditional higher education model and prospects for developing a disruption strategy. There was agreement that enrollment reporting going forward will routinely include nontraditional student populations, including transfer, graduate, online, and noncredit activity.
